Classes on Offer

Art

Work with any media where you will receive individual guidance from the tutor. This is a very relaxed informal class.

Cake Decorating

Various techniques will be used to decorate cakes including decorating novelty cakes, modelling characters out of icing and producing Christmas items.

Cake Decorating-Intermediate

Further techniques to develop your artistic skills. Make a champagne bottle, flowers and fruits are just some things you will learn. Some experience maybe required.

Calligraphy

This course is suitable for beginners and for those with some experience. Learn the art of beautiful writing with a step by step approach. We shall study Foundational Hand, Modern Versals and then progress onto the Caroline Hand in the Spring term. We shall look at layout and design linking your skills to cards, envelopes, invitations, poetry etc. There is an opportunity for those who have a good knowledge and experience of calligraphy to work on your own project with help and guidance. There will be a chance to look at illuminating a single letter with gold leaf and applying calligraphy to different surfaces as we develop our skills. Equipment and materials will be discussed in the first lesson. Linda Winnett, the tutor, is the Secretary to the Birmingham Calligraphy Society.

Computing for OAPs

This class is tailored around the needs of the group which may include on line shopping, mastering eBay, downloading photos, setting up email accounts and how to get the best broadband package etc. It aims to encourage independence, and develop confidence around the use of a computer.

Digital Photography

The photography workshops are designed as a fun and creative way for learning how to take memorable digital photographs. Themes will be around my friends and I, the world around us, travel and transportation, work, rest and play and the photography of movement (including sports activities). The emphasis is on practical hands-on learning, designed to give a better understanding of how a camera works and to demonstrate how to improve images by following some basic principles.

Patchwork and Quilting

Learn a variety of techniques and produce beautiful items such as table runners, cushions, wall hangings and quilts. No experience required.

Spanish—Absolute Beginners

Learn basic Spanish conversation to help you get by on your holidays.

Spanish—Intermediate

Develop a deeper understanding of the language and practice your speaking skills. Build on your existing vocabulary and grammar to help you deal with more complex real-life scenarios. Emphasis will be on speaking and listening but grammar will be included and taught in context including opportunities to look at authentic Spanish press articles and discuss their content.

Stained Glass & Mosaic Workshop

This is a practical course for the beginner and the returning student covering aspects of designing and assembling panels in the traditional leaded and copper foiling technique. It looks at the design and process needed to create beautiful stained glass and mosaic pieces for the home and garden.

Wine Appreciation

An introduction to the fascinating world of wine. The main objective is to appreciate the range of wine types available. The course includes health and safety of wine, systematic wine tasting, viticulture, wine making, grape varieties and a look at some of the major wine-making areas of the world and the wines produced in those regions. Please note there is an additional cost for the wine.

Woodwork

For absolute beginners or for those who want to refresh skills learnt at school. Use hand tools, construction of joints, types and uses of timber, manufactured boards, design, wood finishes and basic wood turning will be covered.
