

Pupil Premium Expenditure

Since September 13 – June 5th 2014 there has been £7313 capital spend covering a range of things including; trips, musical instruments, learning resources, breakfast initiatives, travel support and essential school clothing. Some of this expenditure has gone into asset acquisition, particularly the musical instruments and e- book readers which are 'loaned' to pupils. Tutor resource packs have also been acquired and some staff training and development

Four full time members of staff have been employed through pupil premium along with a range of tutors which also remains the biggest expenditure outside of capital expenses. The impact of which can be seen under 'Latest news' section

All year groups have benefited through pupil premium intervention with the Year 11's having the bulk of tuition particularly with the importance of their final exams, emphasis on tutoring also concentrates on Year 10 and Year 7's.
